



## The School of Professional Studies General Scholarship For the Spring 2016 Semester

**Scholarship Amount:** Dependent upon funding, applicant need, and number of applicants

**Eligibility:** Awards from School of Professional Studies General Scholarship Fund shall be restricted to undergraduate full-time and part-time students who are pursuing a course of study as a declared major of the Bachelor of Professional Studies program or who are pre-Bachelor of Professional Studies students. In addition, students must have completed 15 hours and 2 semesters in the BPS program with a 3.5 GPA or higher.

**Application Process:** Applications should include at least one faculty recommendation, an essay (see the reverse page for the form), a current résumé, and the completed application form (see the reverse of this page for the form). Incomplete applications will not be considered. In evaluating applications, a student's academic merit, professional activities, and volunteer and community service work will be considered. First preference is given to students who are not receiving other College of Charleston scholarships.
